# Major root causes

### Sustainable finance policy

- Command and control doesn't work well.
- Lack of extended liability
- Unawareness of project proponents on international practices (Reputational risk)
- Downsizing or splitting projects for time and cost saving
- Disconnect accountability and decision making

### **Expert committee**

- Limited capacity of human resources and technical skill in the EIA unit
- Acceleration of development process as well as EIA process causing compromised quality of EIA

# **Good practices**

### Sustainable finance policy

- Having integrated approach to review EIA as a part of loan approval
- Sustainable finance system is supported by law in Indonesia
- Results of EIA compliance team were reflected to loan conditions

#### EIA review committee

- Focus on critically high risk areas sectors
- Inviting experts on different sectors and hold in-house expert group
- Internal experts in house
- Prioritizing critical issues to discuss in the committee to make a decision
- Only environmental critical projects go to the expert committee
- Secure accountability of the committee's decision

# Recommendations for policy makers

#### Sustainable finance

- Commercial banks need to follow international standards for the future
- Providing incentives for private sectors to implement environmental and social consideration such as lower interests rate
- In the future, commercial banks need to review EIA, not only check approval of EIA
- ▶ EIA should be done at the same time as finance feasibility review

#### **Expert committee**

- Further consideration of the number of members, membership balance, based on knowledge and experience
- Focus on critical issues, such as high risk areas
- ▶ Efficient review by using scoping and technical guidelines for EIA review
- Good discussion for convergence of view among members
- Need to engage with local government
- Accreditation system for EIA consultants to ensure quality of EIAs
- Local governments, NGOs and local communities should be considered as a member of the experts committee.
- Review need to be accountable for their decision.
